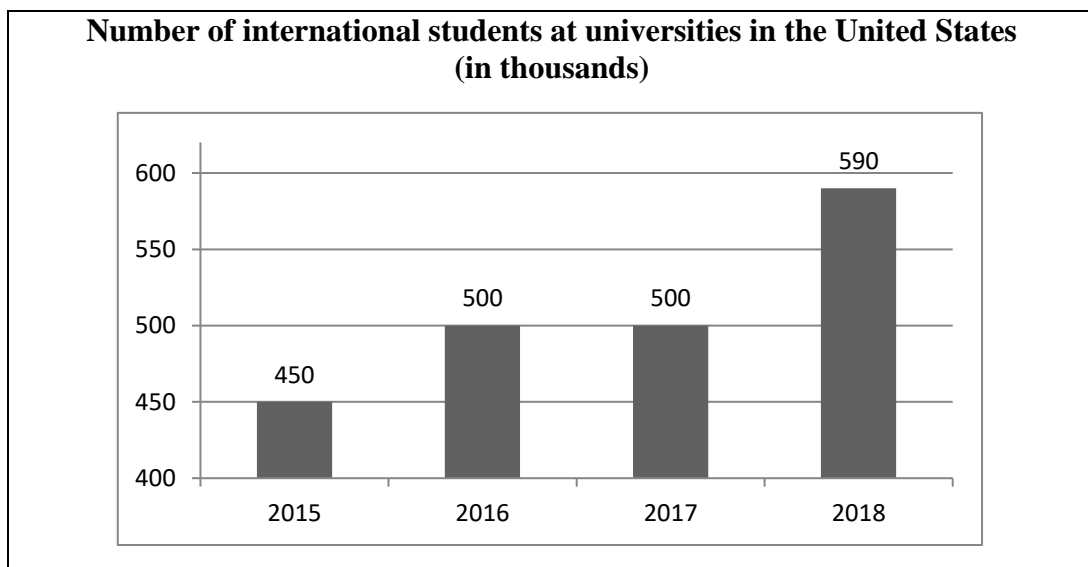


**1. MONOLOGUE****PIRMOJO POROS KANDIDATO**

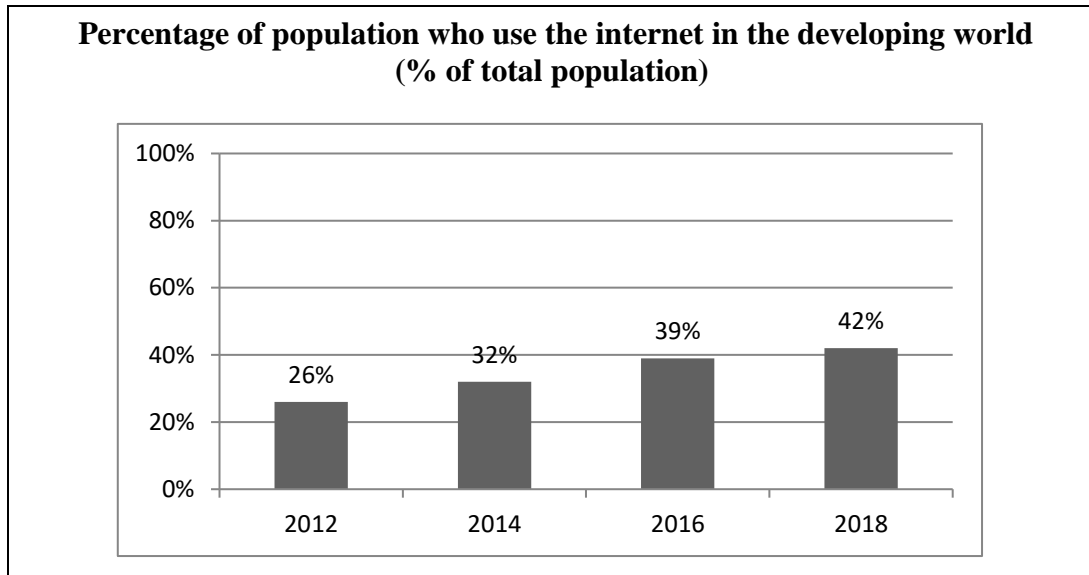
*Time:* 3–4 minutes
