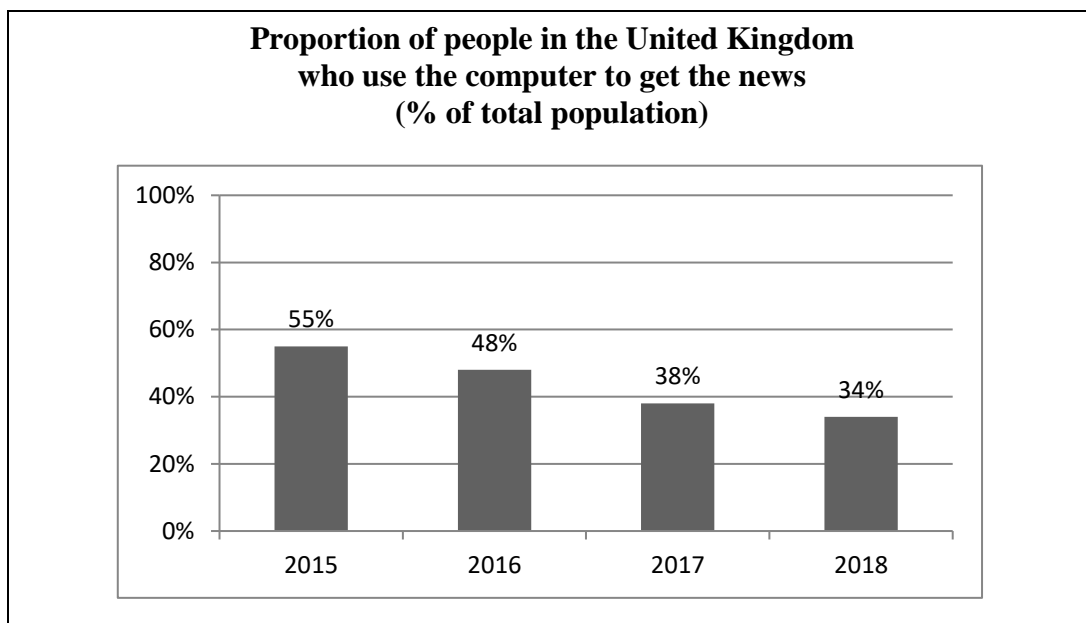

Topic: **Global news**

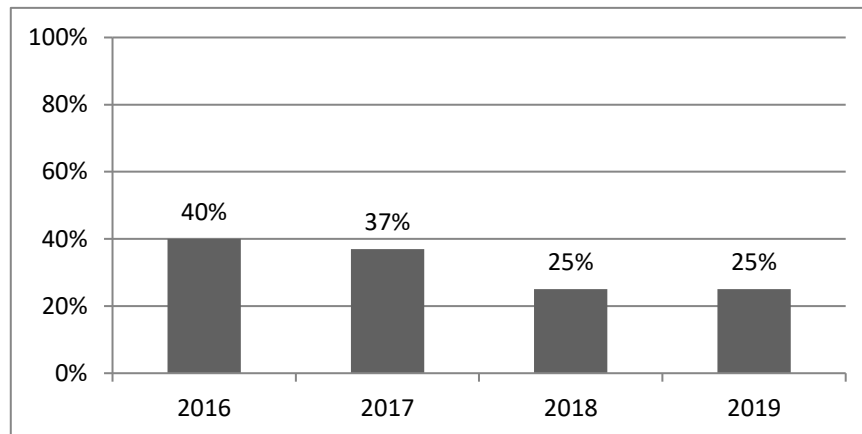
Task: Talk on the given topic. Look at the chart and answer the questions below.
