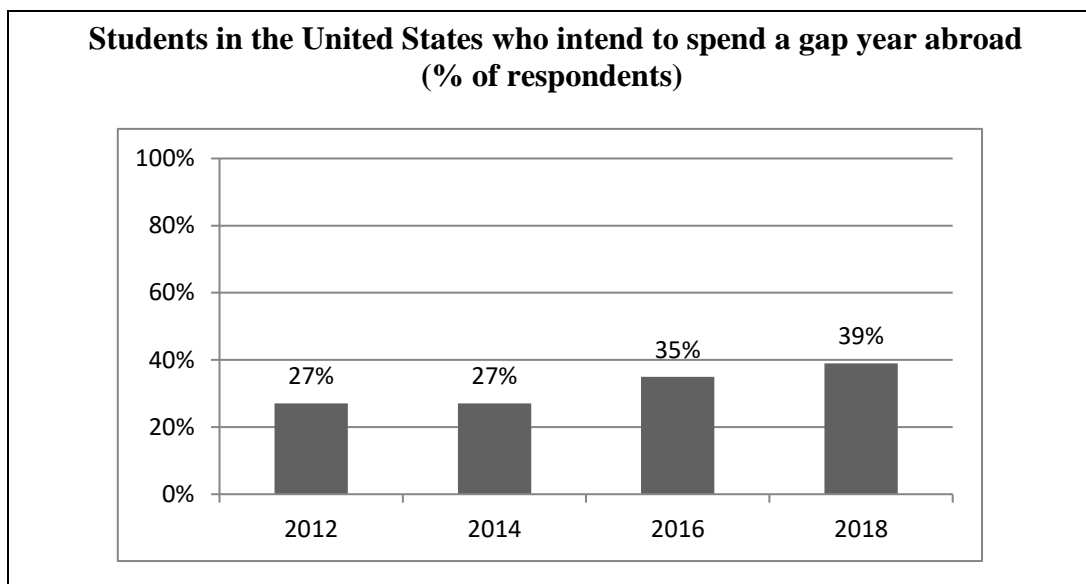

*Topic:* **Gap year abroad**

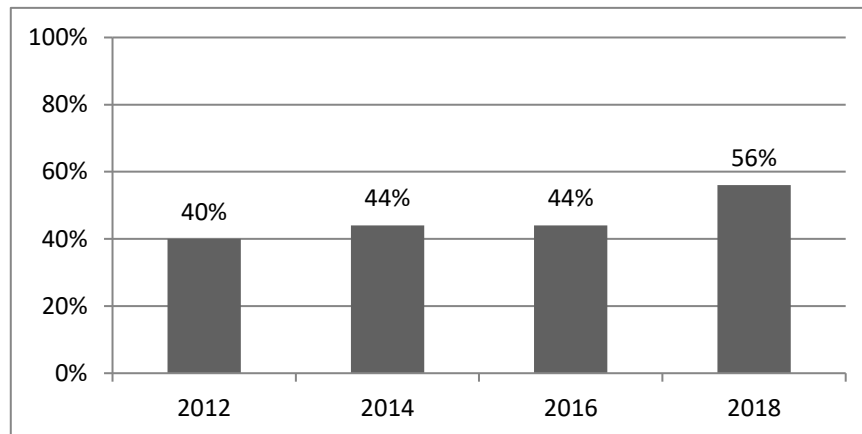
*Task:* Talk on the given topic. Look at the chart and answer the questions below.
