2 užduotis.

Imagine an opportunity to teach teens how to manage their money without facing the risk of losing a single cent. The Budget Challenge is currently offering high school students such a situation.

Fifty eight percent of teens surveyed nationally reported they are concerned that they will not be as financially successful as their parents. One third of parents surveyed reported that they are more comfortable talking to their teens about cigarettes and bullying than they are about money.

An educational program aimed at helping teens learn about financial management has created an interesting initiative to teach teens to manage money. The Budget Challenge is a free, online, learn-by-doing simulation created for high school students. Teachers are invited to register their students to participate in the program.

Once enrolled, students must learn to effectively manage their money to pay common expenses such as rent, utilities, and car payments. Additionally, students are challenged by "real life" budget and spending issues such as unexpected costs for car accidents and lost cell phones.

But perhaps the most exciting benefit of the Budget Challenge is that H&R Block will award \$3 million in classroom grants and scholarships to the top performing participants.

Parents can secure a spot for their teens by encouraging teachers to sign up their class. But hurry, registration for 2015 is coming to an end.

3 užduotis.

Now, the Voice of America Special English program, *Words and Their Stories*.

Many everyday American expressions are based on colors.

Red is a hot color. Americans often use it to express heat. They may say they are "red hot" about something unfair or when they are very angry about something. Fast, loud music is popular with many people. They may say the music is "red hot" – especially the kind called Dixieland jazz.

Pink is a lighter kind of red. People sometimes say they are "in the pink" when they are in good health. It probably comes from the fact that many babies are born with a nice pink color that shows that they are in good health.

Blue is a cool color. The traditional blues music in the United States is slow, sad and soulful. Duke Ellington and his orchestra recorded a famous song – "Mood Indigo" – about the deep blue color, indigo. In the words of the song: "You ain't been blue till you've had that Mood Indigo." Someone who is blue is very sad.

The color green is natural for trees and grass. But it is an unnatural color for humans. A person who has a sick-feeling stomach may say she feels "a little green." A passenger on a boat who is feeling very sick from high waves may look very green.

The color black is used to describe a day in which everything goes wrong. It can be called "a black day." The date of a major tragedy is remembered as "a black day."

Interviewer. Hello Christopher. Why did you come to Lithuania?

Christopher. I have to admit, my arrival in Lithuania was an 'accident'. In late December I saw there was a job available in Vilnius. I do apologise, but my first comment was "Where's Vilnius?" "In Lithuania", was the reply. "It's wonderful – a beautiful city with wonderful people and stunning countryside. It's very beautiful with snow and sparkling blue skies." Well, ... I accepted the job and at the beginning of January I was here.

Interviewer. Are you happy here?

Christopher. Oh, dear! It was such a shock! It was minus twenty, even minus thirty that January, and I was used to temperatures nearer to plus forty. I felt I had made a mistake, but then the spring eventually arrived and now Lithuania is my home every bit as much as Britain, both wonderful each in their own special ways...

Interviewer. Where did you live before coming to Lithuania?

Christopher. Though very much British by birth and culture, I've now spent more than a third of my life beyond its shores: about four years in Africa, here and there across Europe, Asia and South America.

Interviewer. What is it that you miss here?

Christopher. I wanted to live in a hot Mediterranean country. Deep down my desire is still for hotter countries (as you listen to this interview, I will be on an extended trip to Botswana, South Africa and Mozambique).

Interviewer. What do you enjoy the most about being in Lithuania?

Christopher. Living in Lithuania is easy. There are plenty of things to do and see. Lithuania is not a crowded country. It's easy to move around in and find lakes, forests or fields to have a quiet time in. I have been to Nida, a really wonderful place. I spend at least two days every month outside the capital, at places for culture. There are certain gaps in my knowledge of Lithuania – but they will vanish.
