

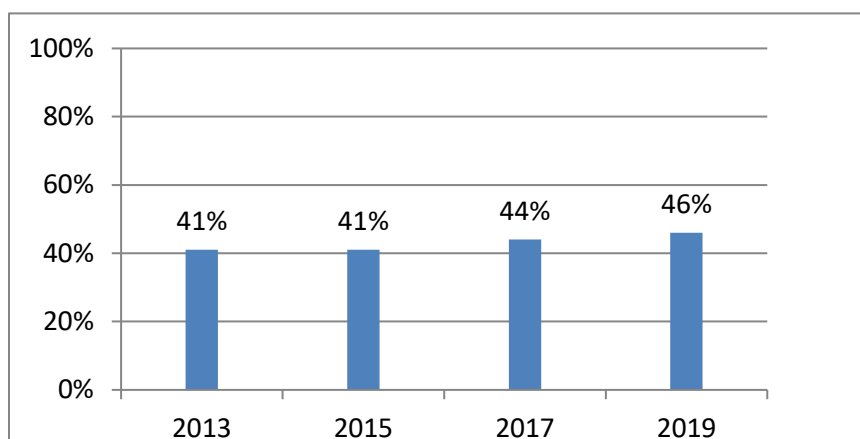

Task: Talk on the given topic. Look at the chart and answer the questions below.

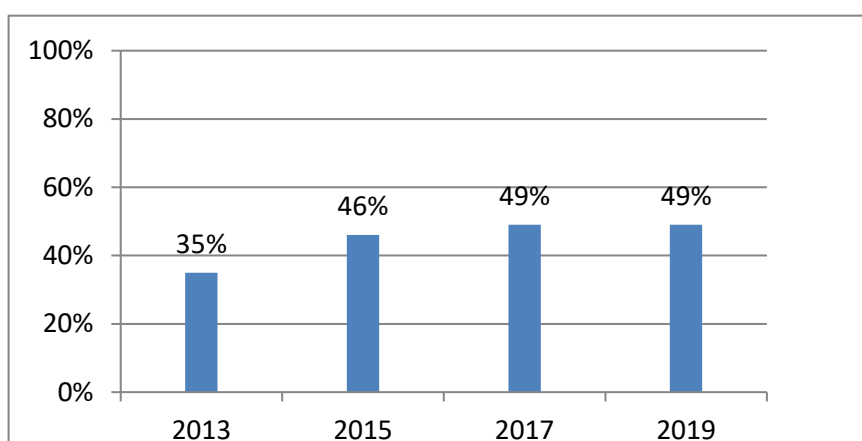
Secondary school students in Poland who would like to work in travel and tourism (% of respondents)
